Guide to present abstracts

To participate in the Poster Session of the XVI International Symposium on Aquaculture Nutrition, please submit your abstract following this Word format: (Abstract). Once we confirm your acceptance, to be included both in the program and the proceedings book, please registry and complete your payment. Please consider due dates for discount rates. **Deadline for submission of abstracts is February 28, 2022.** 

After registering, please submit your e-poster **before March 7, 2022**. It must be in PDF format with the following Format: (PowerPoint). At the same time send a brief video (5 minutes maximum) in mp4 format, or similar. Both, the e-poster, and the video will also be evaluated by the Scientific Committee to select and award the three best undergraduate, and the three best submitted by postgraduate students.

Both files (Word & MP4) must be uploaded in the following link: (<u>Link</u>). You may create a PowerPoint (or similar) presentation up to 10 slides and later convert it to the mp4 video (or similar). The files must not be heavier than 50 MB or you could send us a link in YouTube as well. We'll appreciate that you use the following format (<u>PowerPoint</u>). To fit any screen, please use the slide size of 30x120 cm (wide x height) and be sure to use font size to ensure easy to read in any device.

The structure and content of the e-poster are flexible; however, we encourage you to follow the same structure of the abstract. The e-poster may adapt to the presentation circumstances; although, AENA strongly suggests following the above guidelines. Please use images, pictures, and graphics when strictly necessary.
